

Information from the Coon Rapids Police Department regarding the July Parade:

On Thursday afternoon and evening, July 1, 2010, the City of Coon Rapids will hold its annual July 4th Parade to kick off the annual Firefighters and Lions Club Carnival at Sand Creek Park in Coon Rapids (1008 Northdale Blvd. NW). We will be following the same parade route that this event has used for decades, resulting in the temporary closure of Northdale Blvd. (Anoka County CSAH 11) between Foley Blvd. and Xeon Street between 5:45 pm and 8:00 pm. Detour signs will be posted, detouring ALL TRAFFIC north to 121st Avenue and across.

Below is a PDF map of the parade route in red and shaded area of neighborhoods that will be inaccessible to **ALL TRAFFIC** except emergency vehicles.
