ATTEMPTED ABDUCTION

The police department is seeking assistance from the public in identifying a male suspect involved in an attempted abduction incident.

On Wednesday evening, May 19, 2010 at approximately 9:00 pm, a 19-year old female was the alleged victim of an abduction attempt in the area of 115th Avenue NW and Raven St. NW in Coon Rapids. The female was walking and pushing her infant in a stroller when approached by a male who allegedly took her by the arm and told her to get in his car. She shouted at him and he left in the car. She continued walking home and the suspect pulled up next to her in the car again and once again told her to get into the car. She ran to the closest home and called 911. Police were unable to locate the suspect. A composite of the suspect is below:



The suspect is described as: white male, late 40s to early 50s in age, 5'7" to 5'10" in height, 160 to 180 pounds, black and gray hair with bushy eyebrows, wearing a long gray t-shirt and dark colored pants.

The vehicle is described as a mid-1990s four door sedan, gray in color. The suspect also had a light colored dog with "puffy" fur and large ears.
